



## Province-wide restrictions



By order and direction of the Provincial Health Officer (PHO), all individuals, places of work and businesses in B.C. must significantly reduce their level of social interactions and travel. The new order is in effect from November 19, 2020 at midnight to December 7, 2020 at midnight.

### WEAR YOUR MASK

**Mask requirements:** Masks are now required for everyone in all public indoor settings and workplaces. People who cannot put on or remove a mask on their own are exempt.

- ✓ Employers are expected to enforce the mandatory mask policy with both employees and customers
- ✓ A customer can be refused entry or service if they do not wear a mask

**Masks at workplaces:** Masks are required in all workplaces for shared work areas as well as all areas where physical distancing cannot be maintained. This includes:

- ✓ Elevators
- ✓ Kitchens
- ✓ Hallways
- ✓ Customer counters
- ✓ Break rooms

You are required to wear a mask when you enter any NWT building as well as when you move to and from workstations, work bench, lab space or office.

**If you leave your work space for any reason, wear your mask.**

### Social gatherings and events

**No social gatherings of any size with anyone other than your household**

**For example:**

- ✓ Do not invite friends or extended family to your household
- ✓ Do not host gathering outdoors
- ✓ Do not gather in your backyard
- ✓ Do not have playdates for children
